<b>Being ready for school</b>	Send our/my child to school in full school uniform. Make sure our/my child has the right equipment for school including a school bag and planner	Always wear full school uniform. Bring the right equipment to school in a school bag. <b>Attendance/punctuality</b>	Make sure our/my child attends school on time every day. Inform the school on the first day of absence.	Attend school every day on time. Ensure that teachers and parents know where I am.	Encourage good attendance and punctuality and to reward these. Contact parents at once over any unexplained absence.
<b>Class and homework</b>	Take an interest in the work of our/my child. Encourage our/my child to always do his/her best. Make sure our/my child does his/her homework.	Listen to my teacher and work hard. Write all homework in my planner, do my homework and hand it in on time.	Teach good lessons. Prepare your child in a range of subjects that will allow him/her to succeed in national examinations. Set appropriate work which will be marked regularly. Provide a homework timetable and planner and set homework.
<b>Behaviour</b>	Encourage our/my child to have high standards of behaviour at all times and follow the school rules.	Behave well in and outside of school and follow the code of conduct.	Encourage high standards of behaviour always.
<b>Pastoral support</b>	Let the school know if there are any problems likely to affect our/my child's learning.	Let my teacher know if I have any worries.	Listen and respond quickly to any concerns.
<b>Links with school</b>	Attend parents' consultations. Read letters from school and reply if necessary. Support the school if sanctions, for example, detentions become necessary.	Take all letters home to parent(s). Complete any sanctions, if necessary.	Hold regular parents' consultations. Report regularly on your child's progress, attendance and punctuality. Inform you of any worries or concerns where necessary.
<b>Extra-curricular/ life of the school</b>	Support events that the school is involved in.	Find out what opportunities are open to me.	Inform you of events that the school is involved in.
